Alta means "height" in Spanish and perfectly describes the mountainside site of the Alta home vineyard in the Atlas Peak district of the Napa Valley, as well as owners' Fred and Nina Oliai's aspirations to craft only the best possible, limited release wines from the region.

The 2015 Oso Malo is composed of 92% estate grown Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Petite Verdot and 2% Merlot.

It has a deep purple-black color and delivers notions of ripe black cherry, plum, baked blackberries, with sweet French Oak, mocha and Indian spices. Very big, voluptuous and full-bodied on the palate, it features loads of spicy layers and a firm frame of grainy tannins, finishing long and spicy. There is no shortage of depth in this full bodied Cabernet Sauvignon.
